ROSES: To the five municipalities that have agreed to participate in a regional police study proposed by YorkCounts. Those that have signed on are West York, the City of York and towns covered by Northeastern Regional, which include East Manchester Township and the boroughs of Manchester and Mount Wolf. Here's hoping other municipalities approached by YorkCounts will also agree to be part of the study.

ROSES: Posthumously, to Michael C. Weigland for his public service as a police officer with Latimore Township Police Department and Eastern Adams Regional Police. He died after his motorcycle was hit by a truck during a benefit ride.

ROSES: To West York school district officials for sticking to their guns on the subject of lacrosse. The district said it would add the sport to the lineup if a group of parents raised enough funding for the sport. The group was unable to raise the money. Rather than just chipping in the money with tax dollars, school officials said no. If you say there's support in the community for the sport, you have to put your money where your promise is.
