## YorkCounts to hold annual summit

York, January 7, 2010 – YorkCounts, a broad community coalition dedicated to assessing and enhancing the quality of life in York County, will hold its annual community summit March 26 at the Pullo Family Performing Arts Center on the campus of Penn State York.

YorkCounts presents the summit as way to update the community on the work of YorkCounts from the past year. This year's summit will include the release of YorkCounts annual report, along with presentations on the United Way's Stay in School Report and an update on the York Academy Regional Charter School, both of which grew out of YorkCounts recommendations. YorkCounts leaders will also recognize individuals and businesses that made significant contributions the group's efforts.

Organizers hope to continue the trend of four straight years of increasing attendance. More than 350 people attended last year's summit, which prompted the move to the Pullo Center for this year's event.
